

DA Subpena Seeks Film of JFK Slaying

Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison has subpoenaed Time, Inc., in an attempt to obtain the original Zapruder film of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Garrison, who issued the subpoena yesterday, wants the motion picture film brought before the Orleans Parish grand jury April 4.

Life magazine, a subsidiary of Time, Inc., bought the film from Abraham Zapruder, an amateur Dallas, Tex., photographer.

The DA contends the original film would show that the President was shot from the front, not from the rear, as the Warren Commission concluded.

Garrison said copies viewed by "federal employes" are not "accurate reproductions of the original film."

The subpoena is to be served on a Time representative in Louisiana, if possible. As an alternative, it was to be sent to the Louisiana secretary of state who would forward it to Time headquarters in New York City.
