Dr. Carlos Bringuier, a Cuban refugee, has filed suit in Civil District Court here for \$1 mil-lion damages against Saga

lion damages against Saga Magazine, writer Harold Weis-berg and the publisher of Weis-berg's book, "Whitewash-the Report on the Warren Report." The suit charged that the magazine in April, 1967, print-ed parts of the book in an arti-cle entitled, "Kennedy's Mur-der-Buried Proof of a Conspir-acy." Defendants are the Gambi Publication Inc., owner of the magazine; Weisberg, and the Dell Publishing Co., publisher of the book

Dell Publishing Co., publisher of the book.

Bringuier's petition alleges he was defamed in statements say-ing he was a former Castro gov-ernment official in Cuba until his defection, that he disguised this to the degree possible during sworn testimony before the Warren Commission, and that although he identified himself as salesman and manager of the Casa Boca at 187 Decatur, he was in fact an owner with his brother-in-law, Rolando Peleaz.

Further, said the suit, Brin-guier was defamed by the story which said that on his arrival which said that on his arrival in New Orleans Feb. 13, 1961, he was a delegate of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, and that he is an enemy of the United States who hates the United States more than he does Puscia Russia.

Actually, said the petition, Bringuier is avidly dedicated to the cause of freedom in the Americas and is wholeheartedly a patriot of this country as evidenced in part by documents presented to him by the Chris-tian Crusade and the Informa-tion Council of the Americas.
