Funeral services were held today for Dr. Nicholas J. Chetta, New Orleans coroner, who died Saturday at Mercy Hospital at the age of 50.

The Rev. M. V. Jarreau, S.J., celebrated a Requiem Mass at St. Pius X Church, 6666 Spanish Fort Blvd. The House of Bultman, 338 St. Charles, was in charge of funeral arrangements. There will be private funeral services at Hope Mausoleum.
