New York (UPI) - ... Sander Vanocur, an NBC television newsman and friend of the Kennedy family, .. on a network broadcast last night .. described Edward Kennedy as angry over his brother's assassination... "He does not know whether it is the act of a single person, or whether this is the act of a conspiracy."

From another version/of same story: "They don't know, they don't - they do not know, to put it clumsily. But from him, from others in the plane, one got the impression - it's no more than that - that there's kind of a pattern, faceless men - that's the phrase I heard."

... The late Sen. Robert Kennedy's press secretary, Frank Mankiewicz, later indicated the Kennedys were disturbed by Vanocur's reporting of events during the flight.

"Everyone on the plane was there on the basis of friendship," Mankiewicz said. "There were only friends, colleagues and staff members. Nobody was there as a reporter.

"The plane was private and that is how we view it. We are not going to comment on anything said on the airplane."
