

# Shaw Suit Rejected by U. S. Court

<p>NEW ORLEANS—(UPI)—A three-judge federal panel today refused to stop New Orleans Atty. Jim Garrison's prosecution of Clay Shaw on</p>	<p>charges of conspiring to assassinate John F. Kennedy. The court said, however, their decision did not mean necessarily that Garrison</p>	<p>had a valid case against Shaw. Shaw had filed suit charging that Garrison had conducted a publicity barrage to</p>

convince the public that Kennedy was killed by a team of assassins.

"Our adverse ruling," the decision said, "should not be

construed as an intimation of any view whatsoever on the merits of the pending criminal charge against him (Shaw)."

The decision said Shaw should first seek relief in the state courts.
