Conversation with Bill Turner, (just returned from trip east, including New rleans.

Says Shaw lawyers had filed notice of appeal to U.S. Suppeme Court following their turndown by the three-judge federal panel.

Says they entered the Spatein article from the New Yorker (13july68) into evidence before the three-judge panel denied all their motions.

Said he has turned the article over to his attorney for possible libel suit against Epstein and the New Yorker.

Said Garrison has set a trial date for Shaw of Sept. 12, 1968. Believed this had been done within the past two or three days.

Described the Epstein article as a real hatchet job, full of halftruths and quotations out of context.

Says Sylvia Meagher's hostility to Garrison may stem from her tendency to take the word of people like Novel and Thornley instead of finding out what the facts are. Says he himself has taken depositions from Thornley and it was perfectly obvious he was lying. Says Mrs. "eagher has vehemently denied her Index was financed by the CIA, as alleged by columnist (Allen & Scott ?) (See Allen-Scott column, this file 24 Feb 67.)
