

860 -- Jim Eason hints Epstein may have done his article more than a year ago, at which time the New Yorker turned it down. Says Epstein spent 48 hours in New Orleans in summer of 1967 and perhaps 3 hours in DA's office. *

795 William Turner phone interview. Comments as he reads from Tom Bethell memo to Garrison's staff regarding the errors and false statements in the Epstein article, point by point. Among them:

1072 -- Regarding Epstein's statement that Garrison is politically ambitious (on Aaron Kohn's authority), Turner quotes Garrison as saying that if his investigation is so profitable politically how come no other politician has taken it up?

1095 -- Oswald also visited Miami where he did the same thing he did in New Orleans: passed out pro-castro literature and tried to infiltrate the anti-Castro exile groups.

1130 -- WVUE-TV reporter checked Shaw's arrest record and found the Bertrand alias recorded on it. Turner says he had known about this for some time but said nothing because he assumed it was not to be given out.

1180-- The government agent picking up the bullet in the grass was SA Kyle Clark of the Dallas FBI office.

1245 -- Donald Norton, CIA agent who got worried when Garrison probe started and finally contacted DA from Vancouver.

1395 -- Turner says the Shaw defense obtained advance copies of the Epstein article and entered one into the federal court record. ~~of Shaw's appeal.~~
