A Delay in Shaw's Plot Trial
Ordered by Federal Court
NEW ORLEANS, Aug. 13
(UPI)—A Federal court Tuesday day ordered District Attorney
Jim Garrison to postpone the assassination conspiracy trial of Clay L. Shaw, scheduled for Sept. 10, until the United States Supreme Court could act on Mr. Shaw's request for an injunction by Sept. 10. The same lower court panel dismissed his suit last month, but that destination and deprived him of his constitutional rights. He was arrested March 1, 1967. act on Mr. Shaw's countersuit against the District Attorney.

Mr. Shaw was scheduled to be tried on a charge that he conspired with Lee Harvey Oswald and others to assassinate
President Kennedy in 1963.
A three-judge panel said Tuesday that the Supreme Court
could not possibly act on Mr
