Both Mark Lane and Mort Sahl told me that they didn't think that the Jim Garrison case against Clay Shaw would ever get to trial Both of them told me that the Federal Govt, would stop at nothing to prevent the American people from knowing who mur-dered their President.

I didn't believe them. I couldn't.
Perhaps it was my political naivete or simply my basic faith in the complex, transparent, machinery the points men in the direction of the pursuit of truth. tion of the pursuit of truth.

Whatever it was, I was a believer. When Jim Garrison de-clared on February 18th, 1967 that he had cracked the case never really gave it much thought, But as the months went by, and the opposition to his work increased; as the number of living witnesses and sources of information disappeared; as the unprecedented attacks upon his office from the press increased, I became curious.

My curiosity led to careful, serious investigation into the mountains of material available

to those who are still interested.

And it would take 500 New
Yorker stories by Edward Erskin to convince me that Garrison is an irresponsible, headline seeking, fanatic whose case has no basis in actual fact.

If Jim Garrison had nothing why would so many work as hard to see to it that his nothingness is ever presented in a court of

that trial was to have begun? Why the suppression of Lane's new book?

Why the attacks on the District Attorney of a major city?
Why did 5 dozen people related

to this case in one way or another find themselves dead for reasons other than old age?

I could go on, but it's all part of public record anyway. It was all there for you to see long before this most recent court decision which granted another injunction against Garrison, pending an appeal by Shaw to the United States

Supreme Court.

By the way, if Abe Forts is not seated, which at this stage of the trip, seems unlikely, it is most probable that Earl Warren will hang in for another four years.

If he remains Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, the entire case concerning the murder of Kennedy will have made a complete circle. From the Warren Report back to the Supreme Court. And the question before that austere body of elderly scholars, will be whether or not, Garrison should be allowed to go into a court of law and not only destroy the findings of the Warren Commission report, but also to prove that the CIA along with the help of some other concerned Americans, murdered President

Kennedy. Well, it is unlikely that the Supreme Court will even decide whether or not they wish to hear the arguments in this matter for at least six months and by then, most of the folks will have for-gotten who Clay Shaw or Edgar Eugene Bradley or Hall or Howard or Thornley or Ferrie or any of the others are.

I now no longer believe that the case will ever get to court. I would urge Jim Garrison to write a detailed account of the entire plot and make the book avail-able to all news sources. Obviously it would not appear in the Citizen News, but enough people in this country now read the various underground papers to warrant such a move. The European press has always been fa-vorable to Garrison and would welcome such information.

Garrison should open himself up to a joint slander, libel, de-famation of character, etc. suit. And if any of the people named are that up-tight about the reve-lation, THEY should try to get carrison to court.
