A hearing on a fugitive warrant for Edgar Eugene Bradley of Los Angeles was postponed today for the second time. Mr. Bradley is accused by the district attorney of New Orleans, James Garrison, of having taken part in a conspiracy to assassinate President Johnson [sic] in 1963. District Attorney Garrison is attempting to have Mr. Bradley extradited from California to Louisiana. The reason the hearing was postponed today was that Governor Reagan, who is to decide on the matter of Mr. Bradley's extradition, has not yet reached any decision. Mr. Bradley said today in Los Angeles that he feels confident the Governor will rule against his extradition to Louisiana and Mr. Bradley denied that he was in any way involved in the assassination of President Kennedy.
