[Paraphrase of start of news item: In New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison (today?) hired a lawyer] to prepare a motion asking the Supreme Court to refuse the Clay Shaw presidential assassination conspiracy case. Attorney Ebhard [Eberhard] Deutsch says that in effect a motion he would file soon with the Supreme Court would, if granted, permit Shaw's twice-delayed trial to proceed in Orleans Parish Criminal District Court. Garrison, last March of 1967, arrested Shaw, charging him with conspiracy with Lee Harvey Oswald and others to assassinate President Kennedy. Since then Shaw has fought to avoid facingtrial.
