

Coast Man Is Subpoenaed In Kennedy Death Inquiry

NEW ORLEAN, Oct. 31 (AP) —A grand jury subpoena was issued today for Fred Lee Crisman, of Tacoma, Wash., in connection with the investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy, the District Attorney's office said.

District Attorney Jim Garrison, who directs the controversial investigation, said in an announcement that Mr. Crisman "has been engaged in undercover activity for a part of the industrial warfare complex for years."

Mr. Garrison said his office had developed information regarding a relationship between Mr. Crisman and "persons involved in the assassination of President John Kennedy."
