

Another Try To Move Shaw Trial

New Orleans

Lawyers for Clay L. Shaw, accused of conspiring to assassinate President John F. Kennedy, yesterday filed a new motion to have his pending trial moved out of New Orleans.

It was the fourth motion for a change of venue filed by lawyers for the 55-year-old retired New Orleans businessman who was arrested more than a year ago. Criminal District Judge Edward A. Haggerty denied the other three motions.

Chief Defense Counsel F. Irvin Dymond contended in the new motion his client could not receive a fair trial within a 100-mile radius of New Orleans because of publicity given the case by District Attorney Jim Garrison.
