Eleven of the 14 whites declared that their minds were made up about the case and they wre excused. Only one of the eight Negroes testified to having a fixed opinion of the facts.

By late today, four jurors had been agreed upon, two whites and two Negroes. About one-third of the 85 members remaining on the venire tonight are Negroes.
