FOUND NOT GUILTY of conspiring to murder President John F. Kennedy, New Orleans businessman Clay Shaw (left) shook the hand of each member of the jury which had taken just 56 minutes to acquit him. The verdict dealt a serious blow to New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison's attack on the Warren Commission Report, and Garrison (right) subsequently filed charges against Shaw for perjury, saying he lied when he said he had never met Lee Harvey Oswald, the presumed assassin of Kennedy.
