

Gremillion LL&T Loan Is Repaid

BATON ROUGE (AP) — Records in the East Baton Rouge Parish clerk of court's office today showed that a \$55,000 loan made in May 1968 from Louisiana Loan & Thrift Corp. to Atty. Gen. Jack P. F. Gremillion and state Rep. Richard E. Creek of Baton Rouge has been repaid.

The loan was secured by a mortgage on a Baton Rouge lot with a 145-foot frontage. The 8 per cent loan was to be paid in 120 monthly installments.

LL&T, the controversial firm which is undergoing bankruptcy proceedings, was the subject of investigations by a federal grand jury and the state legislature.

Gremillion was one of several persons indicted by the federal government on charges stemming from the investigation. The trial is pending.
