

**GARRISON RUNNING
IN PRIMARY TODAY**

NEW ORLEANS, Nov. 7 (UPI)—Local politicians think that District Attorney Jim Garrison will probably win reelection, no matter what the press and his opponents have been saying about him.

The politicians feel that Mr. Garrison might have been "off base" in his prosecution of Clay L. Shaw on charges of conspiring to assassinate President Kennedy, but that his loss of the case did not cost him enough votes to lose.

The district attorney's race is one of several bubbling in the final stages before the first Democratic primary election tomorrow. If Mr. Garrison comes in first but does not win a majority, he will face the No. 2 man Dec. 13 in a runoff race for the Democratic nomination.
