The attorney for the New Orleans Aviation Board has been charged with illegal use of \$50,000 belonging to District Attorney Jim Garrison's mother.

The lawyer, Robert G. Haik, was freed on \$2,500 bond and the case was allotted today to the court of Criminal District Judge Mal-

Criminal District Judge Mal-colm V. O'Hara.

The bill of information against Haik was filed Mon-day by Assistant Dist. Atty. William R. Alford Jr. It con-tained few details.

The bill charges that on June 11, 1969, Haik "unlawfully and intentionally did take and use U.S. currency in the amount of \$50,000 belonging to Jane Gardinier without her consent but without the inten-tion to deprive said Jane Gardinier of said U.S. curren-

Mrs. Gardinier lives in

Mississippi.
The law Haik is accused violating is known as the

illegal use of movables stat-ute and is usually invoked against persons who steal au-tos for joyriding without in-tending to keep them.

Haik was an unsuccessful candidate for the state legislature in 1961 and 1962.

HAIK ISSUED this statement:

"Several weeks ago Jim Garrison's mother, Mrs. Jane Garrison Gardinier, instituted suit in U.S. District Court in New Orleans as a result of a dispute over the ownership of oil and gas properties.
"This matter now is pend-

ing in federal court.
"My attorneys have answered this suit and requested some rejudgement. After I filed my answer to Garrison's mother's suit, Jim Garrison has now seen fit to charge me criminally in Criminal District Court.

"HIS EFFORTS to charge me in Criminal District Court are nothing more than an at-tempt to sidestep the jurisdiction of the federal and bring me into what he thinks is his ballpark — the criminal district court.
"These methods of Jim Gar-

rison are nothing more than an effort to force me into capitulating in my defense in the federal court suit: "This is just another exam-

public office for the personal gain of himself and his family."
