

**Clay Shaw's Trial Delayed  
In Kennedy-Slaying Case**

NEW ORLEANS, Jan. 18 (AP) —Clay L. Shaw's second trial in connection with the assassination of President Kennedy was delayed today by an appeal for a Federal court injunction against further prosecution.

Mr. Shaw, 57 years old, was charged with lying to the

Criminal District Court jury that acquitted him in 1969 of conspiring to murder the President.

When the perjury trial opened in Criminal District Court, Judge Malcolm O'Hara, informed of Mr. Shaw's plea for Federal intervention, ruled that he was "compelled to give the U.S. District Court an opportunity to enjoin these proceedings."
