

Hoffa Pays \$10,000 Fine
CHATTANOOGA, June 28 (AP)
— James R. Hoffa, former teamsters president has paid a \$10,000 fine imposed against him when convicted for jury tampering in 1964, United States District Court officials disclosed Monday. The charge stemmed from Hoffa's trial in Nashville in 1962 on alleged conspiracy to violate labor-management laws. The case was declared mistrial after a juror announced he had been approached.
