No Returns Filed By 2 DA Assistants

Internal Revenue Service records reveal the failure of two Orleans Parish assistant district attorney to file individual income tax returns for

several years.

Assistant DA Michael L. Karmazin did not file returns during the period from 1966 to 1969. Karmazin, who works with juvenile cases for DA Jim Garrison, filed delinquently in 1971 for those four years.

The other assistant DA, Frank D. Klein, failed to file returns in 1968, 1969 and 1970, although Klein said yesterday

he filed a partnership tax return each year and accompanied it with a notice of tax liability for his personal return. He was added recently to Garrison's staff and was a private attorney during the years in question, prior to which he had served as Garrison's chief assistant from 1962 to 1964.

"The IRS looks into all allegations of noncompliance it becomes aware of," IRS assistant district director William Orr said, after being asked whether there was an investigation of the two men.
