Hoffa May Win Parole Today

Washington

Former teamster union president James R. Hoffa will make his third bid for parole today, and chances are good that he may win his freedom from the federal penitentiary at Lewisburg, Pa.

The eight-member United States Parole Board agreed to hear Hoffa's plea nearly a year ahead of schedule on the grounds he had presented "new and substantial information." His son James, will plead Hoffa's case.

Hoffa has spent more than four years behind bars on jury tampering and mail fraud convictions.
