

Deportation Review OK'd For Marcello

The 5th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals here has held that Jefferson Parish rackets figure Carlos Marcello is entitled to have his deportation order reviewed by the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service.

The government deported Marcello to Guatemala in 1961 but he made his way back to the United States under mysterious circumstances and has been fighting deportation ever since.

A motion seeking a review of the deportation order was filed with the immigration service last Dec. 9 and denied. Marcello appealed to the 5th Circuit from that denial.

The immigration service ruled that Marcello's motion was premature because he had not lived within the United States for a continuous 10-year period.

The 5th Circuit held yesterday that the appeal was moot and that since Marcello had lived in this country for 10 years he is eligible to reopen the proceedings.
