



Garrison Tax Hearing Postponed

A hearing on a move by Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison to have federal income tax charges dismissed was postponed today because of the illness of the presiding judge.

U.S. Dist. Court Judge Edward J. Boyle Sr. cancelled the hearing which had been set for this afternoon, but set no new date to hear the motions.

Garrison is accused of filing false income tax returns for the years 1966 and 1967.

Garrison is asking that the case be thrown out because of prejudicial pre-indictment publicity in another case in which he and nine others are charged in connection with taking bribes from pinball operators.

The motion charged that Garrison was arrested June 30, 1971, at his home "with great fanfare."
