NEW TURMOIL IN SOUTHEAST ASIA: The overthrow of Cambodia's leader, Prince Sihanouk, was announced in a broadcast from Phnompenh (1). In Laos, fall of Sam Thong (2) to Communist forces was followed by a partial evacuation of nearby Long Tieng. In Thailand, tribesmen were moved from areas (3) where Communist influence was growing.
