**Cambodia Says Saigon  
Sent Supply of Arms**

PNOMPENH, Cambodia,  
April 24—The Cambodian military acknowledged today that the shipment of arms received yesterday consisted of Soviet-designed and Chinese-manufactured AK-47 automatic rifles and ammunition that had been captured from Communist forces in South Vietnam.

Yesterday, after the arms had arrived aboard three cargo planes, Cambodian sources described them as American-made but did not say where they had come from. Today it was acknowledged that they came from Saigon.

High Cambodian officers expressed the hope that the shipment would not be the last.
