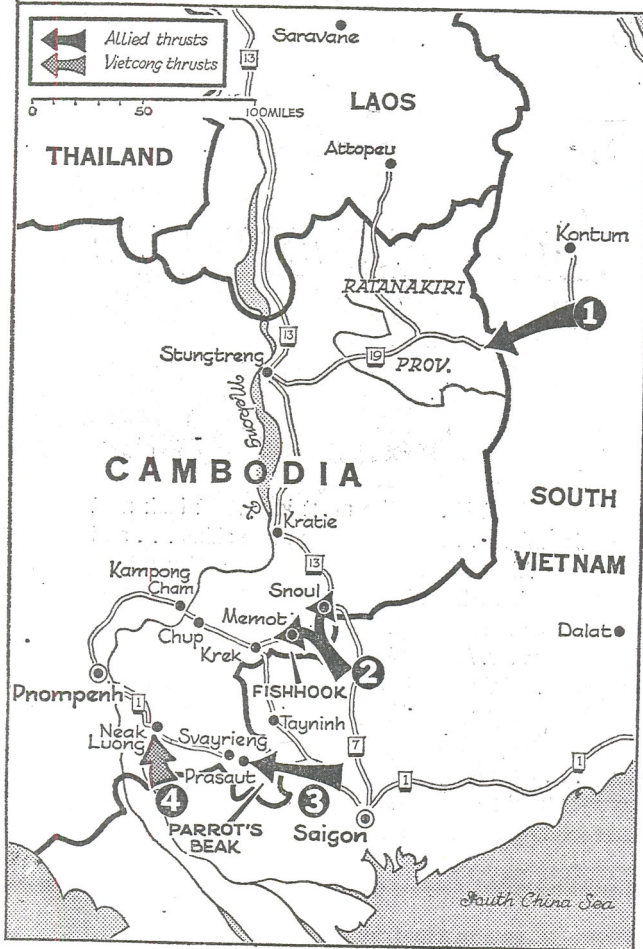


Allies Pursuing 3 Cross-Border Drives in Cambodia

The third major allied operation (1) in Cambodia was opened yesterday in the northeastern province of Ratanakiri. Light contact with Vietnamese Communist forces was reported.

In one of the other allied cross-border operations, in the Fishhook sector (2), northwest of Saigon, additional substantial caches of enemy war materials, food and medical supplies were uncovered.

In the Parrot's Beak (3), sweeps of enemy base camps and suspected areas continued.

The Vietnamese Communist forces (4) that are advancing in the direction of Pnompenh reached a point 27 miles from the capital, but the pressure on it appeared to be more psychological than military.

Red Cross Aide Seeks Data
