CambodiaDeniesSpokesman Was Attacking Saigon's Role

PNOMPENH, Cambodia, May 24 (Agence Frances Presse) -The Government radio today countered a declaration by a military spokesmen Thursday that Cambodians would prefer to die rather than "live under Vietnamese domination."

The radio commentator said the spokesman had not been referring to the South Vietnamese presence in the country. "South Vitnamese forces are in Cambodia to help us liquidate the Vietcong and North Viet-namese aggressors," the com-mentator said. "The Saigon troops were consequently not aimed at in the spokesman's declaration, which has been ex-ploited out of all proportion."

On Thursday the military

spokesman, Major Amron when asked if his comments included the South Vietnamese as well as the Vietcong and Hanoi troops, said he meant all Vietnamese.
