**Cambodia Denies Spokesman
Was Attacking Saigon's Role**

PNOMPENH, Cambodia, May 24 (Agence France Presse) — The Government radio today countered a declaration by a military spokesman Thursday that Cambodians would prefer to die rather than "live under Vietnamese domination."

The radio commentator said the spokesman had not been referring to the South Vietnamese presence in the country. "South Vietnamese forces are in Cambodia to help us liquidate the Vietcong and North Vietnamese aggressors," the commentator said. "The Saigon troops were consequently not aimed at in the spokesman's declaration, which has been exploited out of all proportion."

On Thursday the military spokesman, Major Amron, when asked if his comments included the South Vietnamese as well as the Vietcong and Hanoi troops, said he meant all Vietnamese.
