# Nixon's Cambodia Scoreboard

## San Clemente

In President Nixon's "white paper" report yesterday on the United States military sweep of Communist sanctuaries in Cambodia, he listed these "significant enemy losses."

Ammunition—machine gun rounds, 4,067,177; rifle rounds, 10,094,990, anti-aircraft rounds, 199,552; mortar rounds, 68,539; large rocket rounds, 2123; small rocket rounds, 43,160; recoilless rifle rounds, 29,185; grenades, 62,022; mines, 1482.

Weapons—individual, 22,892; machine guns and artillery, 2509.

Casualties—11,340 enemy killed in action; 2328 prisoner or detainees.

Other—11,688 bunkers; 435 vehicles; 58,600 pounds of communications equipment; 110,800 pounds of medical supplies; 12,400 pounds of documents.
