Weapons—individual, 22,-892; machine guns and artillery, 2509.

Casualties—11,340 e n e m y killed in action; 2328 prisoner or detainees.

Other—11,688 bunkers; 435 vehicles: 58,600 pounds of communications equipment; 110,800 pounds of medical dipplies; 12,400 pounds of documents.
