Pravda Reports Pullback

MOSCOW, March 22—The Soviet press prominently displayed news of South Vietnamese pullback from Laos today.

An article in Pravda, the Communist party newspaper, filed by its correspondent in Laos, said Saigon's forces lost more than 1,000 dead and wounded in withdrawing from Fire Base Lolo a week ago. According to Saigon, the South Vietnamese lost 16 killed and 190 wounded and the enemy 1,100 dead.

The Pravda correspondent, Ivan Shchedrov, who based his figures on a Pathet Lao radio report, said Laotian Communists began attacks on the outpost March 12 and succeeded in dislodging the South Vietnamese March 17.
