U.S. Role Assailed

PARIS, Aug. 23—The Vietcong delegation to the Paris peace talks charged today that the Nixon Administration was carrying out "a new electoral farce to maintain the warlike Nguyen Van Thieu group in power."

The delegation issued a statement alluding to the withdrawal of Gen. Duong Van Minh from the Presidential race and the unsuccessful attempt to get Vice President Nguyen Cao Ky to oppose Mr. Thieu.

The delegation said the events of the last few days showed up the American role as "stage manager" and disposed of American arguments according to which the United States respected the right of self-determination in South Vietnam, that it was not intervening in its internal affairs and was remaining neutral in the election.
