Pnompenh Blaze Put Out

PNOMPENH, Cambodia, Sept. 21 (AP)—Fires in two gasoline storage dumps on the northern outskirts of Pnompenh were finally extinguished today more than 36 hours after tanks had been set ablaze in an enemy attack.

Damage to the tanks and loss of gasoline, fuel oil and diesel oil will run well past \$1-million, oil officials said, but they added that loss of storage space was not as serious as first expected.

The raid cost Cambodia two-fifths of her fuel stocks for civilians, but military supplies were not affected.
