

**HANOI ASSERTS U.S.
MUST HALT FLIGHTS**

SAIGON, South Vietnam, Jan. 28 (AP)—Hanoi said today that

the United States must halt reconnaissance flights over North Vietnam, provide it with reconstruction aid and end "military involvement and intervention" in South Vietnam to obtain a peaceful settlement.

Xuan Thuy, who was chief North Vietnamese delegate to the Paris peace talks, reiterated his Government's speech last night marking the second anniversary of the signing of the cease-fire agreements. The

speech was broadcast by Radio Hanoi.

United States officials have acknowledged that reconnaissance flights have continued over North Vietnam.
