SENATE APPROVES FOREIGN AID BILL

WASHINGTON, March 19 (UPI) — The Senate passed a \$3.9-billion foreign aid appropriations bill today after stripping from it \$59-million in pro-Cambodia, South Vietnam and posed reconstruction and for Laos. The vote was 57 to 40.

Before final passage, the Senate added \$130-million in increased funds for birth control and food programs abroad. Last Thursday the House passed a \$3.5-billion version of

Last Thursday the House passed a \$3.5-billion version of the foreign aid measure, and the two bills now go to a joint conference committee for adjustment of differences.

Congressional leaders, meanwhile, delayed further action on emergency military aid for Cambodia, taking little or no notice of continuing Administration appeals for urgent action.
