mearly one million. It also said that they had established governing bodies in Ban Me Thuot, capital of Darlac Province in the Central Highlands. "Saigon is conducting extermination bombings of many of the district towns and provincial capitals abandoned in recent days by Saigon troops," the broadcast asserted. "Musclemen are also being used to compel people to follow the retreating army. Hundreds of thousands of people have been rushed into disguised concentration camps newly built with U.S. aid, in the provinces of Tay Ninh, Thua Thien, and Quang Tri."

It said that the Vietcong had assigned people to Provincial Capital of Ban Me Thuot, which Was taken by the Communists last week. "Flags, placards and posters have appeared in all neighborhoods," the broadcast said. "On every wall is written the watch-word: 'nothing is more precious than independence and freedom."
