Rejects U.N.

Peace Bid

United Nations

Secretary General Kurt Waldheim was advised the United States that Norodom Sihanouk has turned down his offers to bring together the warring Cambodian sides and try to restore peace to the country.

Waldheim's statement, according to U.N. sources, was made in reply to a letter from Secretary of State Henry Kissinger. Kissinger had asked Waldheim early this month what progress he was making in offering his help to the contending Cambodian factions as requested to do by the General Assembly last fall.
