Sihanouk MAR 2 9 1975 Rejects U.N. Peace Bid

Secretary General Kurt Waldheim was advised the Umited States that Norodom Sihanouk has turned down his offers to bring together the warring Cambodian sides and try fo restore peace to the country.

Waldheim's statement, according to U.N. sources, was made in reply to a letter from Secretary of State Henry Kissinger. Kissinger had asked Waldheim early this month what progress he was making in offering his help to the contending Cambodlan factions as requested to do by the Gemeral Assembly last fall.
