Hanoi Criticizes Ford
For Decision on Ships
HONG KONG, March 30 (Reuters)—North Vietnam and the Vietcong today condemned President Ford's decision to order United States naval ships to Da Nang to evacuate refugees, the North Vietnam press agency reported. The North Vietnamese Foreign Ministry, in a statement issued in Hanoi, called President Ford's order "a very grave violation" of the Paris agreement on Vietnam, according to the agency, which was monitored here. The Vietcong also accused Britain of tailing after the United States by sending a warship to South Vietnam, the agency said.
