14 orphans hit by chicken pox

San Francisco General Hospital was the first stop for 14 Vietnamese children who arrived in the United States with chicken pox.

"Chicken pox is no problem," said Dr. Stephen Kaufman.

"But when you have children in a debilitated condition, there can be some secondary infection — such as chicken pox pneumonia."

Kaufman said all the children on the jetliner have been exposed to the disease, but in the two weeks the disease takes to become active.
