GROUP BACKED BY KY WANTS THIEU TO QUIT

SAIGON, South Vietnam, April 6 (Reuters)—South Vietnam's new Action Committee for National Salvation today called on President Nguyen Van Thieu to resign.

The committee, formed 10 days ago and supported by Nguyen Cao Ky, the former Premier, said that the President had "blamed everyone but himself" in his nationwide address on Friday. The committee said that the President was trying to cling to power.

This was the first time the committee had demanded President Thieu's resignation.
