## Banks Here Say Aides Will Return to Vietnam

Spokesmen for the First National City Bank and Chase Manhattan said in New York yesterday that their Saigon managers were in Hong Kong for consultations with regional managers and planned to return to South Vietnam later this week.

Both spokesmen said their Saigon branches were open for limited business yesterday. Citibank said it had been able to handle some foreign-exchange transactions and Chase Manhattan said its Saigon customers were able to exchange their currency through Charter Bank, a British bank
