

NORTH VIETNAM SAYS U.S. IS A KIDNAPPER

HANOI, North Vietnam, April 8 (Agence France-Presse)—The North Vietnamese Foreign Ministry charked today that the emigration of South Vietnamese adults and children to the United States construed kidnapping.

An communiqué protested against the presence of American war ships and civilians freighters carrying marines in South Vietnamese waters as a serious act of sabotage of the Paris peace agreement.

The communiqué asserted that the same American planes that carried bombs, ammunition and arms to South Vietnam to "massacre the people and devastate the villages" were being used to kidnap South Vietnamese children to the United States.

On Sunday Premier Pham Van Dong, speaking to journalists outside a voting place as North Vietnamese legislative elections were being held, called the airlift pernicious and abominable.

PHNOM PENH, Cambodia, April 8 (UPI)—The United States Embassy has entered into negotiations for a possible airlift of 750 Cambodian orphans daily from Phnom Penh, a spokesman said today.

The airlift was suggested by two freelance journalists, Denis Cameron and Lee Rudakewych, who said it depended on whether humanitarian organizations and adoptions agencies could be found to accept the orphans.
