Dead Children

The bodies of children lay mixed with the garbage near the docks at Nha Trange, 188 miles northeast of Saigon. The children, along with thousands of adults were crowded aboard a garbage scow towed by a Chinese ship which for unexplained reasons cut the scow loose off Nha

Trang. The scow drifted to shore but the children died on the way. They died of thirst, starvation and the panicked brutality of adults, according to a doctor who was aboard. The unclaimed bodies were simply dumped, with the garbage, on the shore.
