Embassy cleaned out after Americans leave

ABOARD THE USS OKINAWA, Gulf of Thailand — After the American evacuation virtually everything left by the U.S. Embassy was looted, including the cars that took the Americans to the evacuation zone. One car was st ripped by a crowd and another stolen, one witness said.

The local press assailed President Ford, Secretary of State Kissinger and the U.S. government.

"America, the great power, is really out to cheat and kill the poor Khmer people," said the newspaper Civilization.

A cartoon in the paper showed Kissinger as Charles Atlas trying to hold up a crumbling world as Ford cringes in terror.
