

More Viet Kids At the Presidio

A dozen more Vietnamese children arrived at the special processing center at The Presidio of San Francisco yesterday after a flight from Saigon to Travis Air Force Base.

A Presidio spokesman said the new arrivals were being given physical examinations and any needed medical treatment before being turned over to adoptive parents.

Since there are now only

17 Vietnamese children still at Harmon Hall Reserve Center, the Presidio no longer is requesting volunteers to help with the children, the spokesman said.

"And we have no word there will be any more children coming here," the spokesman said.

Since the Indochina "babylift" started, 888 children have been received at The Presidio.
