Times Man in Cambodia Honored by State Senate

ALBANY, April 16 — Sydney H. Schanberg, the correspondent of The New York Times who voluntarily remained in Phnom Penh to cover the fighting there, was honored by the State today.

A unanimous resolution commended Mr. Schanberg, who was once The Times's bureau chief here, for "his devotion to duty under hazardous conditions." It expressed the "prayerful hope that he will emerge from this assignment safely."

The resolution was submitted by Senator John Marchi, Staten Island Republican, who was joined by two other Senators who knew Mr. Schanberg when he worked here — Manfred Ohrenstein, Manhattan Democrat, and Jack Bronston, Queens Democrat.
