Advice to Those Who Handled Viet Children

Volunteers who contdacted diarrhea or other symptoms of infection after caring for the Vietnamese children flown here earlier this month should consult their physicians, health officials advised yesterday.

None of tht children showed any evidence thty were carryinc "exotic" or dangerous tropical diseases, accordinS to Dr. Fred Stark at Letterman General hospital.

But many apparently did carry common bacteria and viruses that caused about 300 cases of diarrhta and a few upptr respiratory infections among the 5000 volunteers, Stark said.

There is still the possibility of viral illnesses like hepatitis arising in the volunteers, he said. Physicians whose patients wert among volunteers caring for the Vittnamese children should contact Stark at Letterman. His phone number is 561-4275.
