

# The First Word From Phnom Penh

Saigon

Phnom Penh Radio said this morning in its first broadcast since the Khmer Rouge takeover that the new Communist government is still moving into the capital but indicated some fighting is still going on in Cambodia.

In the first official word from Phnom Penh in five days, information minister Hou Nim said the radio station of the new government has been moved from the northern province of Kratie

to Phnom Penh

In the inaugural broadcast, monitored in Saigon, Hou Nim indicated some fighting continues but he gave no details.

The capital was captured by Khmer Rouge forces last Thursday.

While there was no official word on the fate of Americans and other foreigners who remain in the capital, the Red Cross said it has received messages that they are safe.
